


How to make a Measures Plan for a Student Learning Outcome

Log in to Tk20:

1. Navigate to gmu.tk20.com
2. You will see a George Mason University Shibboleth Login screen
3. Enter your NetID and password (same as what you use to access your email, PatriotWeb, MyMason)

View the assessment plans associated with the degree program's Student Learning Outcomes:

1. Click on Planning tab at the top of the screen
2. Click on Assessment Planning on the side bar navigation
3. Select the organization (degree program) you wish to view
