

How to enter your program's Mission Statement

Log in to Tk20:

1. Navigate to gmu.tk20.com
2. You will see a George Mason University Shibboleth Login screen
3. Enter your NetID and password (same as what you use to access your email, PatriotWeb, MyMason)


View the mission and visions statements:

1. Click on Planning tab at the top of the screen
2. Click on Mission on the side bar navigation
3. Select the organization (degree program) you wish to view
